Manaia Bush Recovery Group Report

In early October, eight keen members of the MBRG set off to work on what was to be a very warm morning.

The work was broken into several components: Jan and Michelle concentrating on The Green, Mike releasing around the recent plantings and controlling half a dozen pines in the plantation forest above, Wayne, Rick and Brian battling the thorns and hundreds of flame tree saplings and branches (as well as arum lily), and Logan Pia and Hans winding their way through the very thick 3-4m native planting in a maintenance weed sweep.

It was not the glamour and romance of working in mature forest, but it was dirty work that needed doing. The flame tree was out of control, having fallen and created a monster of new growth from branches and stems. The old planting area was thick with hundreds of moth plant, Queen of the Night seedlings and masses of arum lily amongst others. Great progress getting to about two-thirds of each of these areas.

The riparian plantings that have been cleared around look really great and the pohutukawa are now over three metres tall and bringing shade to the stream.

This October was our month and as in previous years we targeted a large and weedy area of Darch Point along the Reotahi Coastal Walkway.

Our numbers were significantly boosted when staff from the environmental consulting company [WSP](#) also signed up as part of their annual Community Day. On the day there was a grand total of 20 people working together for 5 solid hours, no mean feat! A wide suite of weeds were controlled including madeira vine, moth plant, queen of the night, elaeagnus, Cape honeysuckle, Japanese honeysuckle, and wild ginger.
